**Need an ANNULMENT and/or CONVALIDATION???**

If you find yourself in the situation where you are living in a marriage that has not been blessed by the Church or cohabitating (living as husband and wife without being actually married) OR you are in need of an annulment in order to have a present marriage convalidated, please contact Fr. Bruce at his email address on the cover of the bulletin. Fr. Bruce will assist you with either or both situations, so that you will be able to start receiving Holy Communion again.

**Mass Intentions** ~ To remember a loved one who has died, or to honor and pray for the intention of another is a beautiful way to call upon God's blessings. The typical offering is \$10 a Mass. If you would like to request a Mass intention for someone, call the parish office, 913-837-2295. One must never forget the infinite graces that flow from the Sacrifice of the Mass, which benefit one's soul.

**Volunteer Sacristans Needed** ~ During the normal schedule of the year, Fr. Bruce sets up all of the sacred vessels and other articles needed for our weekend Masses. However, there will be a few weekends this Fall when Fr. Bruce will be away from the parish fulfilling commitments with his other duties. We are in need of a couple of people who are willing to learn to set-up for Masses for visiting priests, whenever Father Ansems is out of town. If you are interested, please contact the parish office or send Fr. Bruce an email. Thank you for considering volunteering for this behind the scenes ministry!

**Confession and/or Anointing of the Sick Before Hospitalizations** ~ If you know you are going to be admitted to the hospital for surgery, please inform Father Bruce prior to hospitalization and ask for the Sacrament of Reconciliation and/or the Anointing of the Sick. This is a great opportunity for parishioners to receive these sacraments in light of the ongoing pastoral and sacramental relationship that already exists between them and their pastor. Hospital priest chaplains make it their priority to ensure the "Sacrament of the Sick" is offered to Catholic patients, especially when in danger of death. So, please contact Father if you know you will be hospitalized in the near future, and let him know you would like to receive these sacraments before your hospitalization. Or, if you are taken to the hospital unexpectedly, let the hospital staff know that you are Catholic and would like them to contact the Catholic chaplain on call.

**Hymnals and Missalettes in the Pews** ~ When you leave at the end of Mass, please check to make sure the hymnals and missalettes around you are put back with the front covers facing the pew seat. It makes the church look nicer and makes it easier for our ushers to prepare for the next Mass crowd. Thank you for your assistance with this simple housekeeping matter!
