Getting in Spiritual Shape

God's way is always the best way, but it's not always the easiest way - Christ has taught us that to follow him we will always have to carry crosses.

This is why we are vulnerable to temptation. Ever since original sin, we have all been addicted to comfort. We are like electricity, always looking for the path of least resistance.

This is why in a consumer society like ours, where our inborn tendency to comfort and pleasure is constantly being stimulated, we are actually more vulnerable to temptation than perhaps ever before in the history of the Church.

We are told a thousand times a day, in images and words crafted with exquisite artistry, that we should relax, indulge, and take it easy.

How can we defend ourselves against this sleepy, comfort-seeking culture?

One thing we can do is something the saints have been teaching us for centuries: make little voluntary sacrifices every day.

In other words, we can practice picking up little crosses on our own initiative.

Like lifting spiritual weights, this will get us in shape, so we can follow Christ more energetically.

Little crosses:

Our daily lives are filled with hundreds of opportunities to make little sacrifices out of love for Christ, immunizing us against the idolatry of comfort that so easily leads us astray.

- ✚ When we get a headache, we can wait five minutes before taking an aspirin, offering up the discomfort to God as Christ offered up his discomfort on the cross
- ✚ We can take a bigger helping of peas if we don't like peas
- ✚ We can follow the speed limit
- ✚ We can hold our tongues instead of verbalizing useless, hurtful criticism
- ✚ We can fold the laundry perfectly instead of sloppily

God's way is always the best way, but not always the easiest way.

Today, let's promise Christ that we will follow it anyway, just because we love him.
