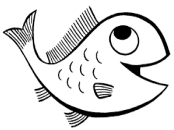

**A Practical Routine Breaker**

Lent is all about breaking out of the routine in our relationship with Christ.

He has so much more He wants to give us, so much He wants to do in our lives and through our lives.

Above all, He wants us to experience the profound and constant joy that only a deep, dynamic, personal friendship with Christ can give. He wants to give that to the world through us.

Today, let’s ask God to give us the grace we need to break out of our routines, and to help others who may not be here today do the same. But let’s also resolve to do something to welcome that grace.

One easy way to do something is to go out of our way for someone every day this week.

We can go out of our way to help someone in little things - like giving up the better parking space, or taking time to actually find information for someone instead of just pointing them to the website.

We can also go out of our way to help someone in bigger things, like taking the family to visit a sick relative in the hospital or the nursing home, or inviting the new family in the neighborhood over for a welcome dinner, or volunteering your most precious resource - time...
