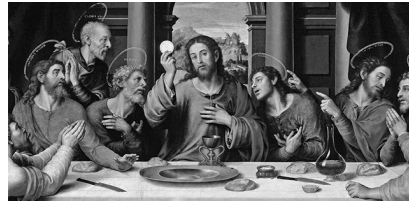

Dispensation Ending on Corpus Christi, June 5-6

Over the past year, a lot of dioceses and archdioceses have dispensed their faithful from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass, due to the pandemic, but still required them to keep holy the Sabbath. As of the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus, this dispensation will be lifted; it will cease to be in effect. What does that mean? It means that the faithful will be once more required to attend Mass on each and every weekend... and why wouldn't we... it's Mass! As in any time of the year, this does not apply to those who are sick or have a genuine underlying medical condition which would prevent them from doing so. The Archbishop will be addressing this topic in a number of his *Leaven* columns. I will address the topic both in the bulletin and from the pulpit. I just wanted to give you a heads-up, so that you can prepare accordingly. *Fr. Bruce*
